**Call to Order**

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Ron Wolff with an introduction of everyone in attendance.

**Approval of Minutes**

Supervisor Robert Crockett made a motion to accept the March 29, 2017 minutes. The motion was unanimously approved.

**Meeting**

Marilyn Ailes was not in attendance to the meeting so it was stated that a meeting could not be held without a quorum, however; Supervisor Robert Crockett stated that Shannon Alexander was now a member of the Committee. The meeting was held as scheduled.

Linda spoke and passed out her report on recycling and talked about the “Trees for Trash”. Robert questioned the Year-to-Date tonnage on the report. She reviewed the probationer program and how much trash they had gotten. She stated there have been questions about the convenience centers and what is allowed in them. A lengthy discussion ensued.

Greg stated that the litter vacuum is back on track but it isn’t running this week but it will be back. Shannon asked if the road segment was tracked and how far in advance do we know which road which will be picked. Greg stated that roads are rated and someone is sent out to look at it.

Greg stated that once the topsoil is put around the base of the cell at the Northern Landfill, the matting will be done around the side and the cell will be technically finished. A discussion ensued.

Greg stated that at Tasley Convenience Center the drawing should be in between now and Friday and he is working with Chris Guvernator. Greg stated that the footprint is not changing. He stated that if you look at where the previous pad was, it looks like four inches of course. He stated how it would be if we went back with four inches of course. He stated that when car wheels turn and twist there won’t be a problem. He stated that Grangeville has been worked on and we may only be able to do a third of the paving. A discussion ensued.

Stewart stated he received a call from Teresa Pittman with the Agricultural Extension Office and she talked about the suppliers suggesting that they may be willing to contribute money to do a cleanup on tires. He

stated the timing for the year for the growers could be in April. He stated that the tire price is \$ 1.14 right now but they are proposing to raise the price to \$ 2.00 per tire. A discussion ensued.

Shannon talked about the report she passed out on roadway segments and talked about the sponsors. A discussion ensued.

Supervisor Robert Crockett made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Shannon Alexander seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved. The meeting was adjourned at 5:10 p.m.
