1). A request from the Crockett Family Irrevocable Trust for a Special Use Permit pursuant to Article III, Section 106-53.5 for the location of a seafood and agricultural wholesaling, retailing and processing facility at 21325 Bayside RD, County Tax Map# 76-A-27, Onancock, Virginia.

Mr. Jon C. Poulson, attorney for the Crockett Family Irrevocable Trust, appeared before the Board to represent this application. The signatures and certified mail receipts from the adjoining property owners were submitted prior to this meeting. Mr. Poulson gave a brief background of the Crockett family and their seafood experience and asked that they be given permission to open a seafood and agricultural processing business in the old 9,000 square foot building once operated by Eastern Shore Seafood.

Mr. John Crockett appeared before the Board and discussed the requirements for the wastewater run-off as per the local health department. He mentioned that this business would be an asset to the community and will bring jobs to the area.
