**Call to Order**

**Old Business & Updates**

Barry Brooks spoke about research he had done with Worcester County on glass recycling and they said they were willing to partner with Accomack County. A lengthy discussion ensued.

Greg stated that the Litter Crew brought in 3.09 tons of roadside litter from Coal Kiln Rd., Killmon Rd. and Lee St., with the aid of the litter vacuum. Greg stated that he also saw the Sheriff's Department out on Sunday. A discussion ensued.

Greg stated that the Northern Landfill Western Expansion Part A Permit Application has been signed off by DEQ and our consultant is putting together the rest of the information for the Part B application. He stated that the application fee is \$18,000 and that everything seems to be on track. A discussion ensued.

Greg stated that we have a small issue with our hazardous waste building as the doors will not open properly. Greg stated that we are in the process of picking a vendor that is going to pick up the hazardous waste. A lengthy discussion ensued.

**Discussion of Operating Procedures at Convenience Centers relative to “limited quantities of household waste”**

Stewart passed out a handout which was the Solid Waste ordinance and a discussion of what a large quantity means. and how it was affecting citizens. Supervisor Ron Wolff stated he had heard different complaints as well. Stewart stated he would like the committee to think about these issues and maybe come to some kind of recommendation. A lengthy discussion ensued.

Shannon stated they just wrapped up a mini grant that they got for a couple thousand dollars from DEQ. A discussion ensued.
