Call to Order

Chairman Ron Wolff called the meeting to order and went around the room to get introductions from everyone.

Consideration of Minutes – September 4, 2019

Old Business & Updates

Linda summarized Assign-A-Highway issues, litter control activities with the Sheriff's office, and Household Hazardous Waste collection for the month of December. A discussion ensued.

Greg stated that the litter vacuum crew collected 3.9 tons of roadside litter and that he instructed staff to report monthly on specific roads that were cleaned. Chairman Wolff asked if Public Works was still working with the Sheriff's Office on the roads. Greg replied that the Sheriff's Office was not doing as many pickups but he does get calls from them for assistance. A discussion ensued.

Greg stated that the Northern Landfill Expansion permitting is in DEQ's hands. Part A has been approved and DEQ is working on part B. A discussion ensued.

Shannon asked if a shelter had been considered for the Household Hazardous Waste collection. Greg responded that it has and options are being weighed. A discussion ensued.

Follow-Up on Operating Procedures at Convenience Centers relative to "limited quantities of household waste"

Stewart stated that there has not been many problems at the convenience centers since allowing larger quantities to be dumped. A discussion ensued.

Consider staff recommendations on revisions to Solid Waste Ordinance

Stewart discussed the proposed revisions to Accomack County's Solid Waste Ordinance with the Committee. A discussion ensued.

Marilyn Ailes made a motion for the Committee to recommend the revisions with one additional change... on page 17, letter C, simply state "Large volumes of waste are prohibited." Barry Brooks seconded the motion.



Adjournment


Shannon Alexander made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Barry Brooks seconded the motion. The motion was carried.
