**Call to Order**

Chairman Ron Wolff called the meeting to order with introductions.

**Consideration of Minutes –August 14, 2024**

Monty Pugh made a motion to accept the August 14, 2024 minutes. Marilyn Ailes seconded the motion. The motion was carried with one abstention, The Honorable Robert Crockett.

**Old Business & Updates**

Greg passed out a handout in Trystan’s absence and discussed how the probationers are a little light and that he has seen VDOT crews working. He stated that we are not getting a lot of hazardous waste material from Northampton County. Chairman Ron Wolff stated that he was at our Fishers Corner Convenience Center to recycle glass. The purple bin was there and when he drove up and looked at the bin/round port, every port had bottles sticking out of it, so he thought the bin was totally full. His question was- “Is there a way that an attendant can keep an eye on this.” Stewart and Greg shared their opinions and stated that they would have Trystan take a look at this. Chairman Ron Wolff asked if there were any updates on the glass collection containers. Greg replied that the goal is to have containers at six sites and the Board has appropriated \$48,000.

He stated that the only site we probably won't have one is Makemie Park Convenience Center because the traffic is low. Sue Mastyl stated that Northampton County wasn't accepting glass. A lengthy discussion ensued.

Monty stated that he sent an email out on the recycling master plan and that it was his suggestion, however, he is not able to work on it right now. The Honorable Jeff Parks stated that a plan like this is of little value unless you are able to dedicate the time necessary to continuously update it. A lengthy discussion ensued.

### New Business & Other

Monty asked if everyone was on board with what he said as far as the master plan goes. Greg asked that once a plan is put together that we don't list who the primary vendor is. The Honorable Jeff Parks was asked by a former Supervisor about one of the sites and if there had been any drama lately. Greg stated that if there were any, he goes straight to the source. The Honorable Jeff Parks stated that this was something related to the landfills. A discussion ensued.

The Honorable Jeff Parks made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Terre Hendricks seconded the motion. The motion was carried with one abstention, The Honorable Robert Crockett.
