


April 2015 EMS Calls By District


April 2015 EMS Calls With Response Time Greater Than 20 Mins.



April 2015 EMS Calls By Response Time










April 2015 Fire Calls By District


April 2015 Fire Calls With Response Time Greater Than 20 Mins.


April 2015 Fire Calls By Response Time




