


August 2016 EMS Calls By Prime Unit


August 2016 EMS Calls By Prime Unit




August 2016 EMS Calls By Response Time









August 2016 EMS Calls By District





August 2016 EMS Calls By District






August 2016 EMS Calls With Response Time Greater Than 20 Mins.





August 2016 Fire Calls By Response Time


August 2016 Fire Calls By Type






August 2016 Fire Calls By Type




August 2016 Fire Calls By District


