Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Ron Wolff. Supervisor Robert Crockett made a motion to accept the August 26, 2015 minutes with corrections and Marilyn Ailes seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Chontese stated that on the Assign-A-Highway program was going well. She stated that the probationers from Northampton County have to do their work through us now and currently she has 4 probationers and for the month of November they had 30 ½ hours already done. She stated that she has reintroduced the office recycling in the County Offices and she has been putting new recycling stickers on the bins. A discussion ensued.

Greg passed out handout on what they have done for North Landfill and South Transfer Station, Litter Vacuum truck and the tonnage is not bad and up from where it was. He stated that he was trying to utilize our guys. Robert asked the question what is your impression of the vacuum truck? Greg stated that he has the guys do the vacuum miles. He also stated that the truck is used at a minimum of twice a week and it depends on how bad the road is. A discussion ensued.

Greg stated that the Grangeville Convenience Center project is 98 to 99% complete and the trim around the windows need doing along with the final inspection. Stewart stated that he was please on how the Grangeville Convenience Center turned out and our staff members who helped make it possible. Greg also stated the cost was very low compared to what it would have costed to have someone built it for us.

Stewart composed a draft with Greg reviewing it to consider a policy regarding lost valuables at Solid Waste facilities. Marilyn suggested on F. of the draft that staff is who should decide if the site is safe or not, Robert agreed. Robert stated that with the waiver has the County Attorney read the draft yet. Stewart stated no he had not met with the County Attorney yet. Ron stated that he met with the Solar folks on Tuesday at the Eastern Shore Community College. He stated they talked about the installation of the solar panels. A lengthy discussion ensued.
