



April 2017 EMS Calls By Prime Unit




April 2017 EMS Calls By Prime Unit




April 2017 EMS Calls By Response Time









April 2017 EMS Calls By District






April 2017 EMS Calls With Response Time Greater Than 20 Mins.


April 2017 Fire Calls By Response Time





April 2017 Fire Calls By Response Time




April 2017 Fire Calls By Type





April 2017 Fire Calls By Type




April 2017 Fire Calls By District




