

ACCOMACK COUNTY WETLANDS MINUTES OF AUGUST 25, 2016

At a meeting of the Accomack County Wetlands Board held on the 25th day of August 2016, in the Accomack County Administration Building Board Chambers, Room #104, in Accomac, Virginia.

DETERMINATION OF A QUORUM

There being a quorum, Chairman Frederick called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

2. MINUTES

No minutes were available to the Board for review and approval.

3. CONTINUED FROM July 21, 2016

A. Mark Dennin – VMRC# 2016-1063

Mr. Dennin has submitted a Joint Wetlands Application to the installation of a riprap revetment along Finney Creek at 23449 Holly Cove Road – near Onancock, Virginia, Tax Map # 83D-1-11 & 12.

Mr. Radak Juran of Perpetual Marine LLC appeared before the Board on behalf of the applicant and was sworn in by Chairman Frederick to represent the proposed project to the Board and reviewed revised drawings that were submitted and additional information presented.

The Board then heard from Mr. Hank Badger, VMRC, who was also sworn in. Discussion ensued regarding revised drawings and options that were given at the last meeting.

On a motion made by Mr. Byrd and seconded by Mr. Ward, the Wetlands Board voted

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to continue this matter for one month to Mr. Mark Dennin to finish the installation of a riprap revetment along Finney Creek at 23449 Holly Cove Road – Onancock, Virginia, 23417, with the following additional information provided to the Board before the next meeting:

- 1.) Put stakes or pipe along front edge and put stakes along the back edge so when the Board goes to the site we can see exactly what area that will covered with stones are and how high/tall and where the stones go.
- 2.) Add cross section of what the toe is going to look like and show mean high & low water to existing drawings.

4. NEW BUSINESS

B. Edward & Christine Richardson, VMRC# 2016-1050

Mr. & Mrs. Richardson has submitted a Joint Wetlands Application to install a replacement bulkhead 2-foot channel ward of the deteriorating bulkhead along the manmade canal on Bayside Drive - Captain's Cove Subdivision, near Greenbackville, Virginia, Tax Map# 5A1-1-958.

No one appeared before the Board to represent this application.

On a motion made by Mr. Ward and seconded by Mr. Taylor, the Wetlands Board voted to postpone this application for one month due to lack of representation from Mr. Edward & Mrs. Christine Richardson to install a replacement bulkhead 2-foot channel ward of the deteriorating bulkhead along the manmade canal on Bayside Drive, near Greenbackville, Virginia, 23356.

5. EXTENSION REQUEST

C. Carlton Mason, VMRC# 2015-0907

Mr. Carlton Mason submitted an extension request to construct nine additional boat slips and associated finger piers & mooring piles on Marsh Island, near Chincoteague, Virginia, TM# 30-A-3 & 3C. (This permit will expire on August 27, 2016)

Ms. Ellen Grimes of CRM LLC, appeared before the Board and was sworn in by Chairman Frederick to represent the extension request to the Board that was submitted there have been no changes in the plans originally submitted for the project.

On a motion made by Mr. Taylor and seconded by Mr. White, the Wetlands Board vote to issue a permit extension (valid for one (1) year) to Mr. Carlton Mason to construct nine additional boat slips and associated finger piers & mooring piles on Marsh Island, near, Chincoteague, Virginia, 23336. With the following condition:

- 1.) With a correction to the proposed project from Single user (private,

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noncommercial) to Multi-user (community, commercial) project.
