

ACCOMACK COUNTY WETLANDS MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 22, 2016

At a meeting of the Accomack County Wetlands Board held on the 22th day of September 2016, in the Accomack County Administration Building Board Chambers, Room #104, in Accomac, Virginia.

1. CALL TO ORDER

There being a quorum, Chairman Frederick called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

2. MINUTES

A. May 26, 2016

On a motion made by Mr. Taylor and seconded by Mr. Ward, the Wetlands Board voted to approve the minutes of the May 26, 2016 meeting.

3. CONTINUED FROM July 21, 2016 and August 25, 2016

A. Mark Dennin, VMRC# 2016-1063

Mr. Dennin has submitted a Joint Wetlands Application to the installation of a riprap revetment along Finney Creek at 23449 Holly Cove Road – near Onancock, Virginia, Tax Map # 83D-1-11 & 12.

Mr. Radak Juran of Perpetual Marine LLC appeared before the Board on behalf of the applicant and was sworn in by Chairman Frederick to represent the proposed project to the Board and reviewed revised drawings that were submitted and dated September 20, 2016 presented to the Board.

The Board then heard from Mr. Randy Owen, VMRC, who was also sworn in. Discussion ensued regarding concerns and possible conditions to add onto the Permit.

A lengthy discussion ensued regarding this proposed project, the marsh grasses in the

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Wetlands Board jurisdiction and possible conditions to add and mitigation fees onto the Permit if approved by the Board.

On a motion made by Mr. Byrd and seconded by Mr. Taylor to issue a permit valid for one (1) year) to Mr. Mark Dennin to construct for the installation of a riprap revetment along Finney Creek at 23449 Holly Cove Road, near Onancock, Virginia, 23417, with the following conditions:

- 1) **The placement of the sill lines must be moved as per the “Frederick” map;**
- 2) **At least Maryland Class 2 stone must be used for the sill and riprap;**
- 3) **Owner must pay mitigation for 50 square feet of impacted vegetated wetlands;**
- 4) **The rip rap section must be limited to a 14-foot length; and**
- 5) **New drawings must be submitted and approved by the Chairman of the Wetlands Board.**

4. CONTINUED FROM AUGUST 25, 2016

B. Edward & Christine Richardson, VMRC# 2016-1050

Mr. & Mrs. Richardson has submitted a Joint Wetlands Application to install a replacement bulkhead 2-foot channel ward of the deteriorating bulkhead along the manmade canal on Bayside Drive - Captain's Cove Subdivision, near Greenbackville, Virginia, Tax Map# 5A1-1-958.

Mr. Edward & Mrs. Christine Richardson appeared before the Board and were sworn in by Chairman Frederick to represent the proposed project to the Board.

Mr. Frederick read the VIMS report into record that identified area of special concerns regarding the shoreline erosion and the height of the bulkhead.

Discussion ensued regarding this proposed project and possible conditions if any to add to the permit.

On a motion made by Mr. Getek and seconded by Mr. Byrd, the Wetlands Board vote to issue a permit (valid for one (1) year) to Mr. Edward & Mrs. Christine Richardson to construct a replacement bulkhead 2-foot channelward of the deteriorating bulkhead along the manmade canal as presented to the Board on Bayside Drive, Captain's Cove Subdivision, County, near Greenbackville, Virginia, 23356.
