Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Ron Wolff. Supervisor Robert Crockett made a motion to accept the September 28, 2016 minutes and Marilyn Ailes seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Greg introduced Linda as our Acting Recycling & Litter Control Specialist and stated that she has put the Assign-A-Highway report together. Linda stated that she couldn't give us number for March because until the month ended but she talked about the January and February numbers. Linda stated that she did meet with the Adult & Juvenile Probations Offices on yesterday and they are working out a plan as to where they are and where they want to go in the future. Linda stated that the Litter Vacuum collected 1.61 tons and Greg stated that it will increase as the weather gets warmer. Linda stated that she is hoping that the hours for the probationers will change. A discussion ensued.

Shannon stated that two contractors were assigned through the Sponsor-A-Highway Program. Holland Road is being sponsored by the Eastern Shore Resource and Conservation Development Council but the signs will actually say Eastern Shore Roundtable instead of RC&D because they thought that might be more appropriate. Shannon stated that the funding has to be spent this year. The second contractor is Harley Davidson of Virginia Beach. They want a sign down on the southern tip but the assignment will still be up on northern end and will continue Greta Road. Shannon showed some Sponsor-A-Highway brochures with beautiful graphics and stated she would share them by email as well. Greg asked for Shannon to email her the list of roads that they are working only. A discussion ensued.

Greg stated that the landfill has received 55 tons of beetle-infested trees from Chincoteague to date. Ron asked if this was separate from the mulch. Greg stated yes. Greg stated he and Bob Fetters are trying to rearrange how we store and manage brush, stone and soil cover for the long term. A discussion ensued.

Greg stated that the floor is done in Cell 3, it is two bales deep, and they are going to pull up the rain cover as needed to minimize leachate. Greg stated that Cell 3 is technically done now. Greg stated that he hasn't called the Bethel Landfill to tell them that they aren't going to receive any more trash yet. A discussion ensued.

Stewart stated that the Convenience Center brush areas subject came up and there was a budget request in for Grangeville Convenience Center. Stewart stated that he took a video of the brush

grinder (Baby Beast) in operation to study the noise and dust levels and he showed the video to the Committee.

Ron stated that he goes to a Convenience Center every Sunday and an issue came up concerning the Put-N-Take area. He also stated that the Put-N-Take was an idea that we came up with. Ron also stated that the other issue is the metal and the bulk containers at the Convenience Centers. Linda stated she has received several calls on the Put-N-Take areas from citizens. A discussion ensued.

Greg talked about the Tasley Convenience Center and stated that once the septic tank is hooked up and the counter top is put in, things should be good to go. Robert stated that the paving money would be in the budget on July 1st. A discussion ensued.

Adjournment
